### General Information

#### 1. Rules

The championship will be conducted in accordance with Rules of the Australian Light Aircraft Championships 2020 (revised)

#### 2. Entry Forms are available on the RFACA website. Please note the closing date of TBA.

Any changes to the details provided on the Entry Form(s) must be notified in writing to the RFACA prior to the start of the Championships. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the RFACA.

Entry Fees will normally be refunded only in the event of the championships being postponed or cancelled. However, where circumstances beyond the control of the competitor compel withdrawal after the closing date, the entry fee may be refunded at the discretion of the RFACA.

3. **RFACA Team Championship** RFACA Member Clubs and Associations wishing to compete for the Federation Trophy must complete and submit a Team Championship Nomination form for each of their teams, and a Competitors Entry form for each nominated team member. The Forced Landing event is mandatory.
4. **Overall Championship** To qualify for the overall championship, a competitor must compete in not less than three events, excluding formation flying. Forced Landing is mandatory. The three events must be nominated before the commencement of the ALACs. The three events may include those entered as a member of an RFACA Club/Association team.
5. **Aerobatics** There will be two levels of Aerobatic competitions. Level 1 – Graduate sequence and Level 2 – Sportsman sequence. The aerobatic sequences will be conducted in accordance with the ALAC and Aerobatic Club Rules. Sequences are available from the RFACA or the aerobatic website [www.aerobaticsaustralia.com.au](http://www.aerobaticsaustralia.com.au). The winner of Level 1 will only be eligible to enter and compete in Level 2 in subsequent years.
6. **Streamer Cutting** The handicap factors are unchanged. Please contact the RFACA or download from the RFACA website [www.rfaca.com.au](http://www.rfaca.com.au).
7. **Aircraft Sharing** Pilots in the Forced landing and Spot landing events are requested to share their aircraft with no more than one other competitor in these events.
8. **Presentation Dinner** The trophies for the ALACs will be presented at a dinner held on Saturday evening at the Echuca Workers Club. The cost is \$65 per head, please indicate on the Competitor entry form the number attending. **Tickets will be available for purchase at the RFACA desk at the Echuca Aero Club on arrival.**
